

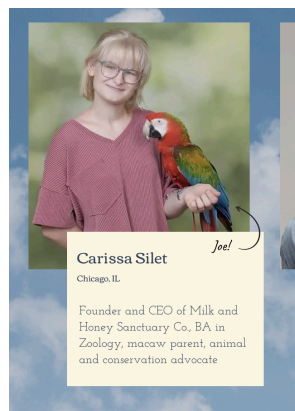
Animal Information Form
